All of the SIR ROBERT BADEN-POWELL commemorative issues, except that of Uruguay, were issued in 1957, the one-hundredth anniversary of his birth. The Uruguay commemorative was issued in 1968. 1957 was also the fiftieth year of Scouting, and both Belgium and Liechtenstein issued pairs of stamps with one value honoring each anniversary. Luxembourg also issued a pair of Baden-Powell memorial stamps, but one was a Girl Scout stamp. Baden-Powell was the founder of Scouting as well as the Chief Scout of the World. His picture appears on many Boy Scout stamps honoring other



These Nicaraguan commemoratives were properly issued in 1957, the one-hundredth anniversary of Baden-Powell's birth. All except two, however, contain the erroneous notation, 1956–1956. The two exceptions picture Joseph A. Harrison, the founder of Scouting in Nicaragua. The 40 cent air mail value shows the presentation of the President's Award, picturing at the left Salvadore Fernandez, Inter-American Executive Commissioner of the World Scout Bureau.



It was then, during the Boer War between the Dutch and British colonists over control of the area, that the British-held city of Mafeking was besieged by the Boers, the Dutch South African forces. Although the city was completely surrounded and isolated, the English garrison, under the command of Colonel Robert Baden-Powell, held out for 217 days until British reinforcements arrived to effect their release.

During this long siege, all able-bodied men were needed for military and other vital activities; so Colonel Baden-Powell organized the boys into a Cadet Corps, under the leadership of Cadet Sergeant Major Warner Goodyear, to carry out messenger and mail services. Since there were no facilities for producing engraved postage stamps, the postal authorities overprinted the Cape of Good Hope, Bechuanaland, and Bechuanaland Protectorate stamps that were on hand with the words "MAFEKING BE-SIEGED." But these stamps quickly ran out. Three stamps were then produced by a process similar to blueprinting. The one-penny value showed a picture of Warner Goodyear on his bicycle; the three-penny value pictured Colonel Baden-Powell on a smaller stamp. Later the size of the three-penny value.

COLONEL BADEN-POWELL'S successful defense of Mafeking, which was an important military post, made him a hero in England; and he rose to the rank of general. A few years later, on his retirement from the army, Sir Robert remembered the enthusiasm and ability of the Cadet Corps and set about organizing a youth program for boys in his native England. From his efforts, and those of Dan Beard in the United States at about the same time, the Boy Scout organization was formed. In later years Lord Baden-Powell often referred to Warner Goodyear as his first Boy Scout.

Czech Scout Post 1918

Although they are not listed by leading American cataloguers because they were not issued by an established government, the stamps illustrated on this page deserve a significant place in a collection of Scouting on Stamps.







At the end of World War I the people of Czechoslovakia gained their freedom from Austria-Hungary. The new government was quickly organized by a Committee of Liberation. But from November 7 to November 25, 1918, the new republic was without an official postal service, and the Sea Scouts were entrusted with the responsibility of carrying the mail for the

Committee in Prague.




Because the political situation was so chaotic, the signature of each Scout was recorded in order that the recipient of the letter could validate the identity of the Scout before accepting the mail and identifying himself. The mail was not prepaid by affixing the stamp. Instead the Scout collected the fee upon delivery, and the stamp merely indicated the amount to be collected.

These two covers (reduced to about one-quarter size) illustrate the signature of the Scouts and the "Posta Skauta" (Scout Post) postmarks. The inscriptions on the stamps themselves read "Czech Scout Post" on the top and "In the Service of the National Government" at the bottom.

When Lord Baden-Powell visited Siam in 1920, King Rama VI was so impressed with the concepts of Scouting that he sponsored the organization and became the first President of the Siamese Scout Association. He arranged for the overprinting of some of the earlier Siamese stamps with the symbol of the "Wild Tiger Corps." These stamps were sold to the public at an advance over the regular postal price, and this difference was used to help finance the Boy Scout organization.

There were three separate overprints, the first reading "Scouts Fund" in Siamese, and the other two with the same wording in both Siamese and English. The kings pictured are Vajiravudh and Chulalongkorn.



Hungary 1925



Hungary issued a set of 8 semi-postal stamps that included among its designs a Boy Scout blowing a bugle. Other designs were sports oriented, showing athletes skiing, skating, diving, fencing, hurdling, parading, and playing soccer. They were sold at double face value, with the extra proceeds used for the support of the Boy Scouts and various athletic organizations. The 1,000 korona value of the set was the first stamp ever issued on which a picture of a Boy Scout appeared.

Romania

Romania issued sets of stamps to help finance the Boy Scout organization in 1931, 1932, 1934, 1935, and 1936. All, except for the 1935 issue, were National Jamboree related. In 1937 the Romanian Boy Scout organization was assimilated into the Strajeri, a larger youth organization, by the Office for the Education of Romanian Youth.











The first Jamboree, held in Bucharest, was called an Exposition. The lowest three values of the set are the first stamps ever to picture various Boy Scout activities. B29 and B30 picture Prince Nicholas, Romanian Chief Scout, and King Carol II, respectively, both in Boy Scout leaders' uniforms.

Since 1925, when Norman Rockwell painted his first picture for the Boy Scouts of America, 1928 and 1930 were the only years he failed to produce a Scout painting for the Scout calendar or the cover of Boy's Life magazine. At the time of his death in 1978 he had prepared fifty such illustrations.

That Liberia should issue this series is appropriate, since Liberia was founded in the early nineteenth century by freedmen from America. In return for the help President James Monroe gave in setting up their form of government, they named their capital "Monrovia".
