



Canada Celebrates the Scouts and Guides

This exhibit illustrates many of the slogan machine cancels and hand stamps used by Canada Post to honour the Boy Scouts and Girl Guides in Canada. It includes some of the auxiliary markings such as registration and other miscellaneous markings that occurred to these covers. These cancellations were typically used in one city or very few cities

The machine cancels include the "Brotherhood" and "Fraternite" series of cancellations used in the 1960's and early 1970's. These were used to honour Baden Powell's birthday of February 22, who was the Founder of Scouting. These slogans were used in up to 18 cities across Canada but only selected ones of each year will be shown in this exhibit. This evolved into what is now known as Scout/Guide Week or Guide /Scout Week in alternating years the week starting and ending on a Sunday with Feb. 22 in it.

There are no known spray cancellations honouring Scouting or Guiding in Canada.


The earliest known date (EKD) and latest known date (LKD) of usage is indicated where appropriate. For multiple cities usage, the dates shown are for the slogan as a whole and not a particular city. Some of the hand cancels such as the 1974 Quebec Jamboree do not have changeable dates, but just show a period of usage such as Aug. 17 to Aug. 24. Typically all cancels were used for less than a month. Significant items are highlighted by a red box.

The exhibit is arranged in a rough chronological order as follows:

- The Early Years 1937-1955 includes the Apple Day slogans and the first World Jamboree held in North America. Pages 2 5
- The Brotherhood Period 1956-1971 a large number of cities used the Brotherhood slogans plus many other Scout and Guide slogans. Pages 6 - 33
- The Later Machine Cancels various Provincial Jamborees and Guide camps plus Polish Scouting and Girl Guide cookies. Pages 34 - 40
- 1983 World Jamboree includes rare trial strikes and related events. Pages 41 45
- The Hand Cancels 1974 present includes Jamborees, Guide camps, Beaver sleepovers, conferences, SOSSI and the 100th anniversary of Scouting. Pages 46 - 80








BUY AN APPLE OCTOBER 30TH TO HELP THE BOYS

This is the first slogan used for the Scouts. Every October many regions in Canada hold an Apple Day as a fund raising event where they ask for a donation for an apple. This slogan was repeated for three years with the appropriate date change. Machine used was Perfect, EKD Oct. 20, LKD Oct. 29.








FRATERNITE 19-26 FEVRIER Y CROIRE - LA VIVRE LA PROPAGER This marks the first year that Montreal used French slogans simultaneously with English slogans for Brotherhood Week. Note that Montreal uses the Roman numeral for the month to avoid bilingual problems. EKD Feb. 19, LKD Feb. 23, used only in Montreal and Quebec on a Pitney-Bowes machine.




SUPPORT SCOUTING



The "75" cancel was used throughout the Jamboree and symbolized the celebration of the 75th anniversary of World Scouting which started in 1907. This celebration started in 1982 and culminated in the World Jamboree.



The First Day cancel for the Scout stamp issued to honour the 75th anniversary of Scouting was used both as a hand stamp applied at the Jamboree and as a machine cancel applied in Ottawa. The two Canadian Scout Organizations are honoured on this cancel - Scouts Canada and Les Scouts du Canada.




A post card based on the design of the scout stamp was also issued by Canada



Unique Trial Strike

These trial strikes are part of a sheet of the only known copies in private hands. These were obtained at a planning meeting with Canada Post where the final cancel design was approved by Canada Post and Scouts Canada. Note that in the final design "Kananaskis Park" was changed to "Kananaskis" due mainly to bilingual considerations.

This cover shows the regular registration stamp applied at the World Jamboree used on July 4, 5 and 7 to 15.



On the First Day of Issue of the Scout stamp, the registration stamp used red ink instead of the regular black ink. The numbering sequence continued from the beginning of the Jamboree.

1974 Quebec Provincial Jamboree held at Camp Tamaracouta near Montreal. Canceller was a fixed date showing the period of the Jamboree.




1st Greater Toronto Regional Jamboree held on Island Park in Lake Ontario. This was also a fixed date canceller used during the whole Jamboree.



At the Canadian Jamboree held in P.E.I. in 1977, the military operated a Post Office and thus two versions of M.P.O. 100 were used during the Jamboree. This was the only usage of military hand cancels at a Scouting event in Canada. Both cancels were used from July 2 to July 10. There was also a special Canada Post handstamp used from July 1 to July 10.








Interestingly, this camp had both a slogan cancel advertising the camp plus a hand cancellation used at the camp.





This Jamboree had many water activities seen in Regattas, thus the combination of Jamboree and Regatta. The canceller was a fixed date for the period of use.




2nd Greater Toronto Jamboree milar but larger cancellation as the 1st Greater

This Jamboree had a similar but larger cancellation as the 1st Greater Toronto Jamboree held in 1975. The canceller used the fixed date range as previously.



The large 81 in this cancel was due to the date stamp kits that came with the cancellers only went up to 1980. This 81 was obtained from Canmore Post Office from an extra parcel canceller and cut down to fit since a replacement couldn't arrive until the second day of the Jamboree. This was only used on the first day (July 1)- subsequent days had the correct font.



The normal cancel above with the new style year, month, day alignment was used for the balance of the Jamboree as shown on the above cover (July 2, 3, 5 to 10). On Ceremonies Day July 4 the third canceller with a day, month, year set up was used.

50th Anniversary of Richmond District

Prior to 1936 there were Scout Groups operating in Richmond but with increasing population Richmond District was formed in 1936. A Scout-O-Rama was held in a local park to celebrate the Jubilee. The canceller was only used on May 31, 1986.




25th Anniversary of Fraser Valley Region

Prior to 1962 the Districts were serviced directly from the B.C.-Yukon Provincial Council. With increasing population, a new Region was needed. The canceller was only used on Nov. 21, 1987




The 5th B.C.-Yukon Provincial Jamboree was held at Camp Bernard in Sooke, B.C. The cancel incorporated elements of the jamboree crest. The registration handstamp was the same as used in 1986 at the Rover Moot. The canceller was used Aug. 8 to 15 inclusive. Canada Post produced a free souvenir post card as shown below.



CJ'89 or the 1989 Canadian Jamboree used a canceller with no date since the date slugs were not supplied with the canceller. In spite of various people advising the Canada Post clerks that this was contrary to postal regulations, mail for the whole Jamboree contained no dates as this registered cover indicates. Note that the registration uses the new self adhesive labels with a printed "R" and a bar code that is used in conjunction with a scanner for better tracking. The Jamboree was from July 15 to July 23.








1993 International Guide Camp


The Scouts On Stamps Society International (SOSSI) held its annual meeting in conjunction with PIPEX (Pacific International Philatelic Exhibition sponsored by the Northwest Federation of Stamp Clubs) in Richmond, B.C. SOSSI was honoured on the second day of the show (Sept. 21, 2002) with a special cancel. H.M. Queen Elizabeth II's picture is reproduced on the cachet in two of only a few stamps showing her in her Girl Guide uniform.

The B.C.-Yukon Provincial Jamboree is the first Jamboree to use the Picture Postage stamps as the official Jamboree stamp. As shown, the centre of the stamp is the Jamboree crest. Only 600 of these stamps exist. The stamps are issued in sheets of 25 pressure activated stamps by Canada Post. The cancel also incorporated part of the design of the crest. The dates the canceller was used were July 5 to July 11, 2003 inclusive.
