





Scouting spread quickly around the world. William R. Boyce, a Chicago publisher, visited London in 1909. Supposedly while lost in the fog, he was asked by a boy if he could help this. This unknown boy refused a tip saying that he could not take a tip as he was a Scout. Boyce became one of the founders of Scouting in USA in February 8, 1910.

Another great youth leader who became part of Scouting in 1910 was Daniel Carter Beard who remained with Scouts until his death in 1941.



Other prominent youth leaders involved in the founding of Boy Scouts of America were naturalist Ernest Thompson Seton who was first Chief Scout in 1910.



#### SCOUTING FOR OLDER BOYS




Something was needed to maintain interest of older boys in Scouting movement. These programs included Air Scouts, Sea Scouts, Rover Scouts

#### **CUB SCOUTS**

Younger boys wanted to be part of Scouting also so a program was developed by Baden-Powell which drew heavily on Rudyard Kiplings <u>Jungle Books</u>. In most countries the program is called Cub Scouts



#### **GIRL GUIDES/SCOUTS**

Shortly after Boy Scouts started in 1907, girls of the same age started clamoring to be included. With the help of his sister, Agnes, the Girl Guides were founded in 1910 in England. This organization spread rapidly world-wide also. In many countries like the USA, they are called Girl Scouts.

#### **BROWNIES**

Like the Boy Scouts, the Girl Guides/Scouts have a separate group for younger Scouts called Brownies. They can be readily distinguished as they wear brown uniforms.

#### **SCOUTING SYMBOLS**

Baden-Powell knew that his new youth movement needed some distinguishing symbols that would be recognized universally. Based upon his knowledge of chivalry and military background, he came up with the Scout badge, sign, salute, left-handed handshake, etc.





The Scouts on Stamps Society International (SOSSI) is a non-profit organization composed of philatelists who specialize in stamps, covers, post cards, seals, etc. relating to the world-wide Scout Movement. SOSSI was started in 1951 as Youth on Stamps (YOS) but changed in 1952 to Scouts on Stamps Society (SOSS) as Harry D. Thorsen, Jr. became the first President. In 1955, its international scope was recognized and the name changed to Scouts on Stamps Society International (SOSSI). The membership currently is about 650 members (475 USA, 25 Canadians, and 150 world-wide).

#### Member benefits include:

- (1) SOSSI Journal: Published six times a year with articles by members about their specialties with many illustrations. The Journal is available electronically in color or as printed copy in black and white depending on the type of membership.
