# Scouts on Stamps

A TOPICAL CHECKLIST

The World Boy Scout Movement was founded in 1907 by Lord Robert Baden-Powell (English, 1857-1941). The organization instructs youth in first aid, camping skills, citizen training, physical fitness and service to others. In 1910, William D. Boyce, a Chicago publisher, on a trip to England, met Baden-Powell and was so impressed with his ideas that he started the Scout movement in the United States. The Girl Scouts or Girl Guides were organized in 1910 and in 1912, the first American Girl Scout troop was formed by Juliette Low. Today over 90 countries and over 50 affiliated territories are members of the Boy Scout World Bureau which has its headquarters in Geneva, Switzerland. There are also Girl Scout organizations in over 50 countries.

It was in 1900, during the siege of Mafeking, in the Boer War in South Africa, that Baden-Powell first conceived the idea of using boys as messengers. The Cape of Good Hope issued a set of three stamps showing Baden-Powell and a messenger on a bicycle. The first stamp actually to picture a Boy Scout was issued by Hungary in 1925 as part of a sports issue.

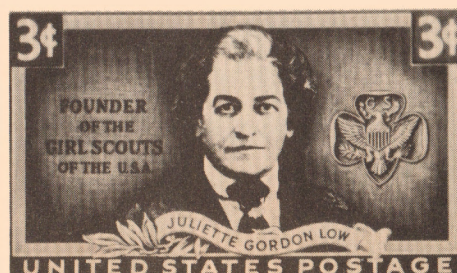
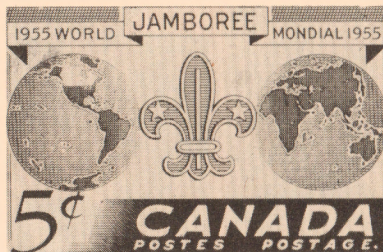


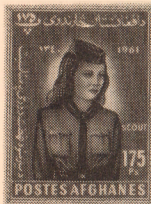
Since then, over 110 countries have issued stamps relating to scouting.
