SHIPS ON STAMPS UNIT, ATA, APS

The SHIPS ON STAMPS UNIT organized in 1954, now has about 275 members in more than 20 countries. Watercraft Philately, the bi-monthly Unit journal, features the histories of ships on stamps, reports on the current status of operating ships depicted, and provides a comprehensive list of recently-issued ship stamps. The Unit has published a book, HISTORICAL SKETCHES OF WATERCRAFT ON STAMPS, and one member has just completed a new edition of ATA's handbook, WATERCRAFT ON STAMPS.

Although the majority of its members belong to some Boy or Girl Scout Association, or have at some time been related to Scouting, SOSSI is a philatelic society, completely independent of any of the World Scout Associations, and not a Scouting organization.

The purpose of the society is to assemble facts regarding stamp issues which honor the Scout Movement and to promote interest in Scouts on stamps among stamp collectors. Through this interchange of ideas among SOSSI members from many countries it is inevitable that there will develop a spirit of international good will.

The *SOSSI Journal* is a monthly publication which is sent to each member of the society. It contains information concerning new issues, research, and little known facts about Scout issues.
